	Your Economy Time Series	National Establishment Time Series (NETS)
<b>Availability</b>	3 months after subject period.	2-3 years after subject year.
<b>Operating establishments</b>	Separates establishments that are verified as in business or are intending to be in business from paper companies – those only registered to hold title to real estate. <sup>1</sup>	Includes operating establishments and paper companies. Records do not indicate establishment status.
<b>Public company information</b>	Includes Central Index Key (CIK) values for 15,000+ companies that are, or have been, publicly traded.	Includes a public/private indicator.
<b>Geographic areas available</b>	US, state, CBSA, county, congressional district, census tract <sup>2</sup> and zip code.	US, state, CBSA, county and zip code.
<b>Formats available</b>	Individual records, aggregated numbers, time series graphs via YourEconomy.org, custom graphs, charts and maps.	Individual records.
